JESSE FISCHER & SOUL CYCLE

On his new album Retro Future, Brooklyn-based keyboardist, composer, and producer Jesse Fischer weaves together many different strands of futuristic sounds from the past to create a brand new sound that is ahead of its time yet incredibly cemented in the present. The ambitious project ties together jazz, electronic, soul, classical, hip-hop, psychedelia, and world music. Retro Future was released October 30, 2012, and peaked at #23 on the iTunes Jazz Charts and #38 on the Amazon Hot and New Charts in its first week.

Following up 2011's independent release, Homebrew (which featured turns from Gretchen Parlato, Stefon Harris, and Sean Jones), Retro Future marks Fischer's label debut with ObliqSound, and features his tight-knit working group Soul Cycle. Emerging vocalists Rachel Eckroth and Chris Turner are also featured on one song each. The album includes seven originals along with compelling new takes on The 5th Dimension's "Aquarius", Jimi Hendrix's "Electric Ladyland", and Fleetwood Mac's "Landslide".

A triple-threat as a self-taught musician, engineer, and producer, Fischer has performed, engineered, or produced for Stevie Wonder, Freddie Jackson, Black Moon, N'Dambi, Laura Izibor, Ryan Shaw, Lakecia Benjamin, and Koko Jones. He recently engineered, produced, and performed on Laura Izibor's latest EP, The Brooklyn Sessions, Vol. 1, which is currently available on Atlantic Records.

RACHEL ECKROTH

In her latest project, Pianist/Vocalist Rachel Eckroth breaks away from her jazz roots to present a group of songs in what she describes as a singer-songwriter outing fused with jazz, pop and R&B sensibilities.

The band features Chris Parrello on guitar, David Cutler on bass, Jesse Fischer on keyboards, and Jerome Jennings on drums.

"With sparse, staccato bass notes and fluid string arrangements, Rachel Eckroth's music is a little outside the contemporary singer-songwriter box. Indeed, the songs contain few of the formulaic components that have made the female singer-songwriter genre like a dependable old friend. There is no weeping piano (even though Eckroth is a trained pianist) or solemn guitar, and it is absent of the hyper-personal lyrics trademarked by Alanis Morrisette and Fiona Apple. Eckroth speaks in poetry, and while not necessarily better than a hyper-personal approach, it causes the listener to sit up and pay attention. Mino Cinelu

As child, Mino Cinelu first learned to play the guitar. He discovered the drums and percussion and then became professional musician at the age of sixteen. Traveling between London and New York, he collaborated with a huge number of musicians, both in the studios and onstage, people whose origins (jazz, funk, rap, electro, flamenco and pop) were as diverse as Mino's associations with them were prestigious (Miles Davis, Sting, Weather Report, Herbie Hancock, Lou Reed, Vicente Amigo, Stevie Wonder, etc...) As a composer, multi-instrumentalist, programmer and producer, Mino has left mark on many kind of music, and his reputation has earned him the status of "a man of all talents".

Will Calhoun

In addition to his work with Two Grammy winning band Living Colour, Will has recorded and/or toured with diverse artists including B.B. King, Mick Jagger, Jaco Pastorious, Harry Belafonte, Pharoah Sanders, Oumou Sangare, Jack Dejohnette, Paul Simon, The Allman Brothers, Lauryn Hill, Marcus Miller, Dr. John, Herb Alpert, Rolling Stones guitarist Ron Wood, Wayne Shorter (on the Grammy-winning CD "High Life"), Lauryn Hill, and recorded with rappers Run-DMC, Public Enemy and Mos Def. As a producer, player, and songwriter, Will has worked on Herb Alpert's Grammy-nominated CD-colors, and Mos Def's New Danger.
